## AN ACT

To amend sections 1, 3, 8 and 9 of Public Law No. 20-42, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 20-54, 20-64, 20-67, 20-83, 20-94 and 20-103, in order to appropriate \$73,140,000 of additional funds from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2018, to provide funding for the operations of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, various grants, subsidies and contributions and Capital and Human Resources Development, including additional funding for the FSM Trust Fund, and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 20-42, as amended by
- 2 Public Laws Nos. 20-54, 20-67, 20-83, 20-94 and 20-103, is hereby

- subsidies and contributions and Capital and Human
- 12 Resources Development. The National Government's share
- of the Amended Compact funds has been reduced to zero;
- 14 EXCEPT THAT; the National Government will retain 10
- 15 percent of the Supplemental Education Grant funds as is
- reflected in the budget for the Department of Education.
