A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend sections 1, 2, 3, 8, and 9 of Public Law No. 19-118, as amended by Public Laws No. 19-125, 19-131, and 19-135, in order to appropriate \$1,410,390 of additional funds from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2017, to correct for a technical error regarding SEG funding in the amount of \$556,074, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1           Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 19-118, as amended  
2 by Public Laws Nos. 19-125, 19-131, and 19-135, is hereby  
3 further amended to read as follows:

4           "Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this act is as  
5 follows: To appropriate the sum of [~~\$70,677,981~~  
6 \$72,644,445 from the General Fund of the Federated  
7 States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending  
8 September 30, 2017, for the purpose of funding the  
9 operations of all branches of the National Government  
10 of the Federated States of Micronesia, its agencies,  
11 various programs, grants, subsidies and contributions  
12 and Capital and Human Resources Development. The  
13 National Government's share of the Amended Compact  
14 funds has been reduced to zero; EXCEPT THAT, the  
15 National Government will retain 10 percent of the  
16 Supplemental Education Grant funds as is reflected in  
17 the budget for the Department of Education. The sum
