



TOOLS USED IN MAKING CANOE


THE SAW IS USED IN CUTTING SMALLER TREES, IT IS A VERY HANDY TOOL, TOO.


THE ADZE CAN BE USED BOTH INSIDE AND OUTSIDE THE CANOE.


IN CANOE-MAKING DIFFERENT TOOLS ARE USED FOR DIFFERENT PURPOSES.


