A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend sections 1, 3, 8 and 12 of Public Law No. 20-42, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 20-54, 20-64 and 20-67, in order to appropriate \$820,000 of additional funds from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2018, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 15 Education Grant funds as is reflected in the budget for the
- Department of Education. The sum appropriated herein shall be
- 17 apportioned as follows:"

Allotment and Management of Funds and Lapse 4 5 Dates. 6 (1) General provisions. 7 (a) All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in 8 accordance with applicable law, including, but not limited 9 10 to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. 11 (b) The allottees shall be responsible for ensuring 12 that these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the purposes specified in this act, and 13 14 that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sums 15 appropriated. 16 (2) Allottees. The allottees of the funds appropriated 17 by this act are as follows: 18 (a) Section 2 - the allottee of these funds shall be 19 the President of the Federated States of Micronesia; 20 (b) Section 3 - the allottee of these funds shall be 21 the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated States of 22 Micronesia; 23 (c) Section 4 - the allottee of these funds shall be the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the Federated 24

States of Micronesia;

1 (d) Section 5 - the allottee of these funds shall be the Public Auditor of the Federated States of Micronesia; 2 3 (e) Sections 6 through 9 - the allottee of these funds shall be the President of the Federated States of 4 Micronesia; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that for the following 5 subsections of sections 8 through 9 of this act: 6 7 (i) Section 8(1)(g) - the allottee of these funds shall be the Chair of the Joint Committee on Compact Review 8 9 and Planning; (ii) Section 8(9) - the allottee of these funds 10 11 shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia; 12 (iii) Section 8(12)(a) - the allottee of these 13 funds shall be the President of the College of Micronesia-14 15 FSM; 16 (iv) Section 8(12)(e) through (h) - the allottee of these funds shall be the Chief Justice of the respective 17 State Supreme Court; 18 (v) Section 9(1) - the allottee of these funds 19 20 shall be the President of the College of Micronesia-FSM; 21 (vi) Section 9(16)(a) - the allottee of these funds shall be the President of the Federated States of 22 Micronesia; EXCEPT THAT, for the share of funds from this 23 line item for the Conservation Society in Chuuk, the 24 allottee shall be the Governor of the State of Chuuk, AND, 25
