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A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend sections 1, 3, 8 and 12 of Public Law No. 20-42, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 20-54, 20-64 and 20-67, in order to appropriate \$820,000 of additional funds from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2018, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1       Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 20-42, as amended by  
2 Public Law No. 20-54, is hereby further amended to read as  
3 follows:

4       "Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this act is to  
5 appropriate the sum of [~~\$82,129,033~~] \$82,949,033 from the  
6 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the  
7 fiscal year ending September 30, 2018, for the purpose of  
8 funding the operations of all branches of the National  
9 Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its  
10 agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and  
11 contributions and Capital and Human Resources Development.  
12 The National Government's share of the Amended Compact funds  
13 has been reduced to zero; EXCEPT THAT; the National  
14 Government will retain 10 percent of the Supplemental  
15 Education Grant funds as is reflected in the budget for the  
16 Department of Education. The sum appropriated herein shall be  
17 apportioned as follows:"

18       Section 2. Section 3 of Public Law No. 20-42, as amended by  
19 Public Law No. 20-67, is hereby further amended to read as

1 follows:

2 Section 3. Operating Expenses of the Legislative  
 3 Branch. The sum of [~~\$5,733,285~~] \$6,153,285, or so much  
 4 thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the  
 5 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the  
 6 fiscal year ending September 30, 2018, for the operations of  
 7 the Legislative Branch of the National Government during  
 8 fiscal year 2018. The sum appropriated by this section shall  
 9 be apportioned as follows:

10 (1) Speaker and Members.

11 The sum of [~~\$2,882,498~~] \$3,022,498, or so much thereof as  
 12 may be necessary, for the operations of the Office of the  
 13 Speaker and Members of the Congress of the Federated States

1       Section 4. Section 12 of Public Law No. 20-42, as amended  
2 by Public Laws Nos. 20-64 and 20-67, is hereby further amended  
3 to read as follows:

4       Section 12. Allotment and Management of Funds and Lapse  
5 Dates.

6       (1) General provisions.

7               (a) All funds appropriated by this act shall be  
8 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in  
9 accordance with applicable law, including, but not limited  
10 to, the Financial Management Act of 1979.

11              (b) The allottees shall be responsible for ensuring  
12 that these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary,  
13 are used solely for the purposes specified in this act, and  
14 that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sums  
15 appropriated.

16       (2) Allottees. The allottees of the funds appropriated  
17 by this act are as follows:

18              (a) Section 2 - the allottee of these funds shall be  
19 the President of the Federated States of Micronesia;

20              (b) Section 3 - the allottee of these funds shall be  
21 the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated States of  
22 Micronesia;

23              (c) Section 4 - the allottee of these funds shall be  
24 the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the Federated  
25 States of Micronesia;

1           (d) Section 5 – the allottee of these funds shall be  
2           the Public Auditor of the Federated States of Micronesia;

3           (e) Sections 6 through 9 – the allottee of these  
4           funds shall be the President of the Federated States of  
5           Micronesia; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that for the following  
6           subsections of sections 8 through 9 of this act:

7                   (i) Section 8(1)(g) – the allottee of these funds  
8                   shall be the Chair of the Joint Committee on Compact Review  
9                   and Planning;

10                   (ii) Section 8(9) – the allottee of these funds  
11                   shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated  
12                   States of Micronesia;

13                   (iii) Section 8(12)(a) – the allottee of these  
14                   funds shall be the President of the College of Micronesia-  
15                   FSM;

16                   (iv) Section 8(12)(e) through (h) – the allottee  
17                   of these funds shall be the Chief Justice of the respective  
18                   State Supreme Court;

19                   (v) Section 9(1) – the allottee of these funds  
20                   shall be the President of the College of Micronesia-FSM;

21                   (vi) Section 9(16)(a) – the allottee of these  
22                   funds shall be the President of the Federated States of  
23                   Micronesia; EXCEPT THAT, for the share of funds from this  
24                   line item for the Conservation Society in Chuuk, the  
25                   allottee shall be the Governor of the State of Chuuk, AND,

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1 for the share of funds from this line item for the  
2 Conservation Society in Yap, the allottee shall be the  
3 Governor of the State of Yap, AND, for the share of funds  
4 from this line item for the Conservation Society in Kosrae,  
5 the allottee shall be the Kosrae Civil Society;

6 (vii) Section 9(16)(f) – the allottee of these  
7 funds shall be the Governor of the State of Yap;

8 (viii) Section 8(12)(v) through (y) – the  
9 allottee of these funds shall be the Governor of the  
10 respective State.

11 (3) Lapse date. The authority of the allottees to  
12 obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as of  
13 September 30, 2018; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that the funds  
14 appropriated under section 9 of this act shall not lapse.”

15 Section 5. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
16 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its  
17 becoming law without such approval.
